The International Association of Marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA) in association with the Hellenic Navy Lighthouse Service and under the auspices of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, the Hellenic Maritime Museum and the Aikaterini Laskaridis Foundation is hosting a Seminar on the Preservation of Lighthouse Heritage. It will be held in Piraeus, Greece on 3 – 7 June 2013. There is a limit of 100 delegates and 30 students; registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

Background

Objectives

The objectives of the seminar are to:

- ✓ Share expertise;
- ✓ Identify best practice; and
- ✓ Establish the strategic challenges which its members face after 15 years of IALA's efforts to promote the different aspects of lighthouse heritage.

This should provide a review of the topics covered in previous seminars: Alternative or Complementary Use, Historic Lighthouse Maintenance and the impact of modern technology and also provide possible solutions to the stated aim, 'The Preservation of Lighthouse Heritage'.

It is anticipated that conclusions and recommendations from the seminar will provide guidance for heritage and AtoN authorities and that they may provide indicators for the work of IALA in its 2014 - 2018 work programme.

Parallel exhibitions on Historic Lighthouses will be presented, such as exhibits at the Lighthouse Authority Museum, the exhibition "Historic Lighthouses: from the past to the future" organized by the EC-PHAROS Project, student architectural designs by NTUA, photographs and other artefacts related to lighthouses. In addition, documentaries about historic lighthouses will be shown, whilst invited speakers who have devoted their lives to lighthouses will share their experience.
